

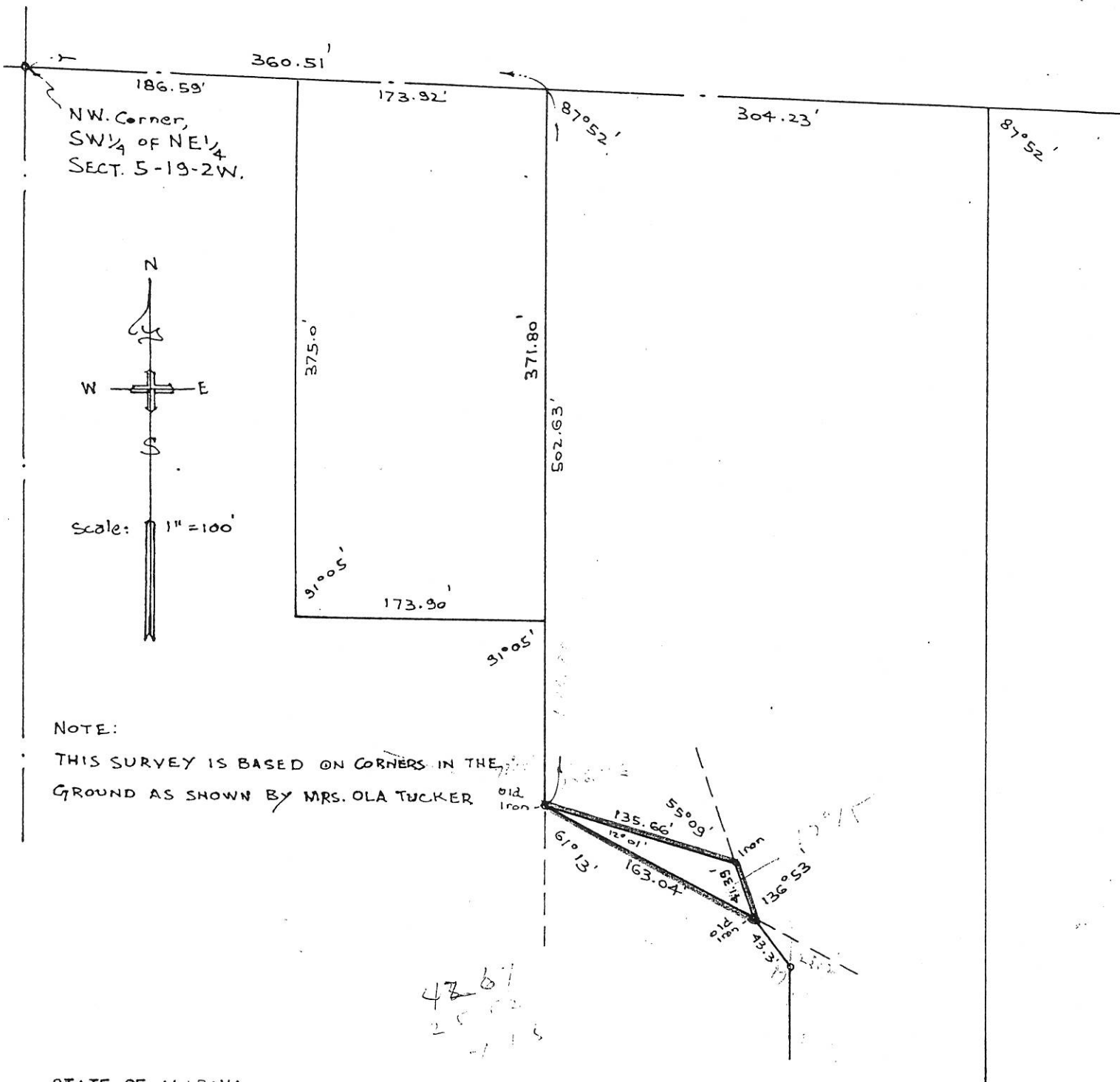

John S. Gustin III, a registered Land Surveyor of Birmingham, Alabama, hereby certify the foregoing to be a true and correct map plat of part of the Southwest Quarter of the Northeast Quarter of Section 5, Township 19 South, Range 2 West, more particularly described as follows:

Commence at the Northwest corner of said Section; thence run East along the North line of said Section 186.59 feet to the point of beginning of the Tract herein described; thence continue East along the North line of said Section 478.15304 feet; thence turn an angle to the right of 87° 52' and run South a measured distance of 957.46 feet to the center-line of Lower Rocky Ridge Road as the same is located and constructed; thence turn a measured angle to the right of 123° 53' and run Northwesterly along said center-line a measured distance of 172.0 feet; thence turn a measured angle to the right of 55° 57' and run Northerly a measured distance of 250.0 feet; thence turn an angle to the left of 23° 52' and run Northwesterly a distance of 42.3 feet; thence turn an angle to the left of 37° 21' and continue in a Northwesterly direction a distance of 163.04 feet; thence turn a measured angle to the right of 61° 18' and run Northerly a measured distance of 129.87 feet to a point which is 371.8 feet South of the North line of said Section; thence turn a measured angle to the left of 88° 51' and run Westerly 173.9 feet; thence turn an angle to the right of 88° 51' and run Northerly 375.0 feet to the point of beginning; except a triangle off the Southwesterly side of said Tract which is more particularly described as follows: Commence at the Northwest corner of the Southwest Quarter of the Northeast Quarter of Section 5, Township 19 South, Range 2 West and run East along the North line of said Section a distance of 186.59 feet; thence turn a measured angle to the right of 87° 48' and run South 375.0 feet; thence turn a measured angle to the left of 88° 51' and run Easterly 173.90 feet; thence turn a measured angle to the right of 88° 51' and run Southerly a measured distance of 129.87 feet to the point of beginning of the tract herein described; thence turn a measured angle to the left of 61° 18' and run Southeastwardly a distance of 163.04 feet; thence turn an angle to the left of 136° 52' and run Northwesterly 41.39 feet to the point of beginning; that the buildings now erected on said property are within the boundaries of same; that there are no encroachments by buildings now erected on adjoining properties; that this property is not situated within a Flood-Prone area according to the U.S. Department of the Interior Geological Survey Map of Flood-Prone Areas, Map #161-0; that the correct Street address is #2921 Lower Rocky Ridge Road (Old Rocky Ridge Road), Rocky Ridge District, Jefferson County, Alabama.

WHITSON, A REGISTERED-LICENSED LAND SURVEYOR OF BIRMINGHAM, ALABAMA HEREBY CERTIFY THE FOREGOING TO BE A TRUE AND CORRECT MAP OR PLAT OF A PARCEL OF LAND LOCATED IN THE SOUTHWEST  $\frac{1}{4}$  OF THE NORTHEAST  $\frac{1}{4}$  OF SECTION 5, TOWNSHIP 19 SOUTH, RANGE 2 WEST MORE PARTICULARLY DESCRIBED AS FOLLOWS: COMMENCE AT THE NORTHWEST CORNER OF SAID SOUTHWEST  $\frac{1}{4}$  OF THE NORTHEAST  $\frac{1}{4}$  OF SECTION 5, TOWNSHIP 19 SOUTH, RANGE 2 WEST; THENCE RUN EAST LONG THE NORTH LINE OF SAID  $\frac{1}{4}$  SECTION FOR A DISTANCE OF 360.51'; THENCE TURN AN ANGLE TO THE RIGHT OF 87°52' AND RUN SOUTH A DISTANCE OF 502.63' TO THE POINT OF BEGINNING OF THE TRACT OR PARCEL HEREIN DESCRIBED; THENCE TURN AN ANGLE TO THE LEFT OF 61°13' AND RUN SOUTHEASTERLY A DISTANCE OF 163.04'; THENCE TURN AN ANGLE TO THE LEFT OF 136°53' AND RUN NORTHWESTERLY A DISTANCE OF 41.39'; THENCE TURN AN ANGLE TO THE LEFT OF 55°09' AND RUN WESTERLY A DISTANCE OF 135.66' TO THE POINT OF BEGINNING.-SITUATED IN JEFFERSON COUNTY, ALABAMA.
